

Scrapbook Page 7: refer to Photo 7

Materials;

Recollections 12" x 12" paper, I used a light blue; go with your color theme

Paper-Papers: Hinted gold 92lb, cover, and FAV Shimmer, Pure Gold, 92lb cover

Spellbinders: M-Bossabilities, Dainty Dots

Red Liner Tape 1/8" & 1/4"

Any round punch, 1"

Spellbinders: Nestabilities, Label Twenty-Eight

Memory Box: Lady Peony Background & Lady Peony Outline

Martha Stewart Gold Leaf Stickers

Some Odd Shaped Pieces left over from cutting out the gold peony outline.

Spray adhesive & glue, your choice

Instructions:

Using the red liner 1/4" tape, apply the background colored 12" x 12" paper to the scrapbook page. Emboss the full 8.5" X 11" Hinted Gold sheet with tiny dots. I used the Big Shot Pro. Use anything you have that works. People have used a rolling pin, rotating the die around the page. It all looks great. It looks great plain, also. The paper just shimmers wonderfully. Using the Peony background die, cut a flower from the Hinted Gold embossed paper. You can outline it and use an exacto blade. Apply the embossed paper to the background page with 1/4" red liner tape.

Using the Peony outline, cut the shape from the Pure Gold. The outline will fit through a regular Big Shot or Cuttlebug. Spray adhesive and a touch of glue will hold it to the embossed paper. Next is the Labels Twenty-Eight die: I used two size, one larger. I embossed the outer gold background, not the inside one. The inside picture was not tall enough for the die, but I like it anyway.

Cut background for other pictures 1/2" wider than the picture, so the borders are 1/4". My backgrounds are Pure Gold. Using the same Pure Gold, I printed the wording on the cover stock, using an inkjet, but the laser works also. If cover stock won't bend through your printer, use text stock. After printing, I used the round punch to cut them out. Using various sizes of red liner tape, apply the photos to the gold backgrounds and then to the embossed paper. I used red liner tape and a touch of glue since the paper is embossed. The tape holds it in place until the glue dries and prevents bleed through from too much glue. Tuck in the name tags and apply the leaf stickers and the cut out shapes from the peony, that were left over from the die cut. You are done.
