Scrapbook Page 8: refer to Photo 8

Materials;

Recollections 12" x 12" paper, I used a light blue, go with your color theme

Paper-Papers: Hinted gold 92lb, cover, and FAV Shimmer, Pure Gold, 92lb cover

Spellbinders: M-Bossabilities, Dainty Dots

Red Liner Tape, 1/8" & 1/4"

Cottage Cutz: Bella Floral Border

Martha Stewart Gold Leaf Stickers & Cherry Blossom Flower Border Punch

Spray adhesive & glue, your choice

Instructions:

Using the red liner 1/4" tape, apply the background colored 12" x 12" paper to the scrapbook page. I broke up the background page with sections of colored paper. Emboss the full 8.5" X 11" Hinted Gold sheet with tiny dots. I used the Big Shot Pro. Use anything you have that works. People have used a rolling pin, rotating the die around the page. It all looks great. It looks great plain, also. The paper just shimmers wonderfully. Tape the embossed paper to the background paper

Cut the Pure Gold 1/2" bigger than the photos, so you have a 1/4" border on all sides. On one I left a bigger border to add some flowers. Print the name tags on the Pure Gold cardstock and cut out. Using the Floral Border, cut 2 in one of the background colors. Using the Martha Stewart flower punch, cut some flowers in a contrasting color.

Using Red Liner tape of various sizes arrange and tape everything in place. The spray adhesive will help with the floral borders and a touch glue behind anything going on the embossed surface will hold it down best. Apply the leaf sticker. I left enough edge between the red liner tape and edge of the photo mounts so that I could slip the name tags behind the pictures and tape them down.

You are done with page 8.
